## C.I.T. PROGRAM

Students currently in 7th or 8th grade are eligible for the Counselors-in-Training (CIT) program. Students should have 3-4 years playing a SummerMUSIC instrument, including some private instruction. These students, along with high school counselors, will mentor the younger students, based on the El Sistema model of music education.
