

Entering from Tremont St.

- Walk towards the CMCB sign in between the sign for the Boston Center of the Arts on your left and the Calderwood Pavilion sign on the right.
- Walk towards the double doors under the sign. Pull them towards you or press the automatic door button on your right. There will be an elevator directly in front of you, and a set of stairs with 9 steps on your left.
 - If you take the elevator, go down one floor, you will take a left out of the elevator down the short hall, and find the CMCB door on your right.
- At the bottom, directly in front of the steps there will be the Boston Gay Men's chorus sign. Turn to your right and walk down a short hall, towards a door with the CMCB sign above it.
- Once there, there will be a doorbell near shoulder or head level on the left. Ring the doorbell. Once the door clicks, it is unlocked. Pull it towards you and enter the hallway with framed images on the walls. Walk towards the double doors directly ahead.
- Past those double doors there will be pictures of young people playing instruments.
- As you keep going down the hall there will be a double-door entrance to the Allen hall on the left. Continue forward, through two more sets of double doors.
- Continuing forward there will be a black loveseat on the left right next to the women's bathroom.
- Take a slight right past another set of double doors, then pass two offices on the right and two bathrooms on the left.
- At the end of the hall there will be a main waiting area, with a black sofa on the right and a waiting table on the left. Behind the waiting table is the front office. The black sofa is next to a set of double doors leading to the exit on Warren Ave.

Entering from 34 Warren Ave.

- At this entrance, there will be a black and gold CMCB sign above a set of green double doors.
- Pull the door towards you, and directly in front are a set of stairs with 12 steps, with a wheelchair accessible chairlift on the left wall.
- At the bottom, take a right to find a set of green double doors, leading to the main waiting area. Pull them towards you to open.
- There will be a black sofa a few steps to your right and a waiting table across from that black sofa. The front office is located behind the waiting table. The entrance to the front office is to the left of the waiting table. You are welcome to either speak to the individual seated at the welcome table. If no one is seated there, please feel free to enter the office behind the welcome table to request any information that you might need.
- If you walk to the left from that main waiting area, there will be a short hall with offices on your left, and two bathrooms on the right.
- Past a set of double doors, there will be a black loveseat to your right, next to another bathroom. Continuing forward you will see rehearsal room A on your left.
- Approximately 10 steps further down the hall, you will arrive at one of the entrances into Allen Hall on the right.
- Past the hallway double doors, there will be another Allen Hall entrance on your right.
- Continuing forward, there will be doors for rehearsal room B on the left, and a final set of hallway double doors in front of you.
- At the end of the hallway you'll find the exit door. Push it to open. The door will lock behind you once closed. Past this door will be the elevator on your left, which will take you up one floor to the Tremont St. exit. Once you step out of the elevator the doors leading to the street will be directly in front of you.
- If you continue forward instead, there will be the Boston Gay Men's chorus sign on your right and a set of stairs with 9 steps to your left. Once you walk up the steps, they also lead you to Tremont St. through a set of double doors on the right.
